

1. That the club colours always remain the same as the original colours from the inaugural 2013 season: royal blue, black, white, navy blue and yellow.
2. That the Football Committee shall consist of the Club Chairman, Operations Director and Club Secretary who will appoint the following positions at the start of each season:

A 1st Team Manager, 1st Team Captain, 2nd Team Manager, 2nd Team Captain, Social Secretary, Women's Representative, Chief Scout, Social Media Manager, 1st Team Assistant coach, 2nd Team Assistant coach. An individual may occupy multiple roles.

3. That the Club Chairman and football committee have the power to decide, pro. tem., any matter not provided for by these rules.
4. That the game will be played in accordance with the laws of the Football Association and within the rules of the Manchester FA.
5. That the teams for Men's matches be chosen by a selection committee, consisting of the Club Chairman, Operations Director and the Manager and Captain of each team.
6. Selection policy to incorporate the following points within the weekly selection process: -
 - A. In a situation where Chorlton have three or more teams, that any players can be dropped or promoted only one side at a time from the teams selected the previous week. The exception to this being, that the 1st Team Manager or Captain has the sole right to select any player within the Club.
 - B. Any player is entitled to seek clarification concerning their individual selection from the Selection Committee through the Club Chairman.
6. That the Football Committee and the Selection Committee have the power to suspend any player who brings the game into disrepute or transgresses the rules of the Club. All suspensions shall be reviewed at the earliest Football Committee meeting if the decision has been taken by the Selection Committee.
7. That any member selected to play in an 11-a-side or small-sided match at training or in the league be notified by a team-sheet prior to the day of the match. If a member is unable to play the session, they should IMMEDIATELY inform the nominated Selection Committee member. In the interests of consistent team selection, players who are aware of their unavailability for any period, should inform the nominated Selection Committee member.
8. That the Club will provide all shirts, shorts and socks for players representing Chorlton FC.
9. That all members of a team are expected to carry out such duties as may be required of them by the Manager or Captain of that team or by any

Committee Member on the day of a match. Any player failing to comply with this request will be liable to suspension.

10. That if required, all members of a team are expected to assist in engaging with match officials, volunteers, visitors and spectators. Additionally, players are expected to meet at the designated 'clubhouse' after 11am matches when possible.
11. That all players are expected to arrive promptly at the arranged meeting place/venue for home and away fixtures. Members who fail to appear for matches or arrive persistently late at the meeting place/venue will be liable to suspension by the Selection Committee. Players who are regularly more than 20 minutes late at the prearranged meeting place/venue may be dropped or suspended.
12. That any player, at the request of the Selection Committee or the resident Manager or Captain, who refuses to play for a higher or lower side as a direct result of replacing a player who has dropped out, will be liable to suspension unless there are extenuating circumstances.
13. That any player who fails to appear at the meeting place or venue then, subject to agreement between the relevant Manager or Captain, the higher or lower side may take priority in fielding the strongest eleven.
14. That the Club fully expects all players to maintain a high level of good conduct and behaviour on and off the field of play, respecting the laws of the game and the officials who apply them. The club also values fairness and transparency, and thus offers managers, captains and players alike the opportunity to participate in managing the club's discipline. The club will apply its own disciplinary procedure in addition to the FA/MFA process and sanctions.

Cautions

Upon receiving a caution, the player must pay their Manchester FA fine to a member of The Selection Committee within 1 week of the related match/caution. After that, a nominal fine will be applied in accordance with the Manchester FA fine system.

15. Members of the 'Club' shall pay an Annual Subscription and a per-session fee in accordance with the decision taken at the A.G.M. of the Chorlton Football

Club. These amounts will be published in the end of season newsletter and will be available through the Football Committee.

16. That members of the Football and Selection Committees shall see that these rules are strictly adhered to and report any offenders who shall be dealt with by the Football Committee as they deem fit.
17. A Summer membership renewals period will follow the close of the season, where club members are invited by the Club Committee to apply for membership for the following season.
18. Member renewals, new applications for membership and nominations for new applicants of 'Chorlton Football Club' will be considered by the Football Committee before being submitted to the Club Chairman for election. New members, on notification of their election, will be presented with a set of Club Rules.
